Jon Keeyes, already noticed for his *"American Nightmare"* with Miss Debbie Rochon, comes back on screens with *"Hallow's End"*. We stay here in B movies style, but with quality ! First, technically, *"Hallow's End"* has nothing to envy to big productions : the images are fluids and well filmed, the music match perfectly with the lugubrious atmosphere, the actors are quite convincing and the special effects and make up are great (above all the gore effects in the opening scene!). The story itself stays quite basic even if it is believable. The complex relationships between the caracters give a certain rhythm to the movie which stays entertaining but with some dispensable scenes which could have been cut when edited.
